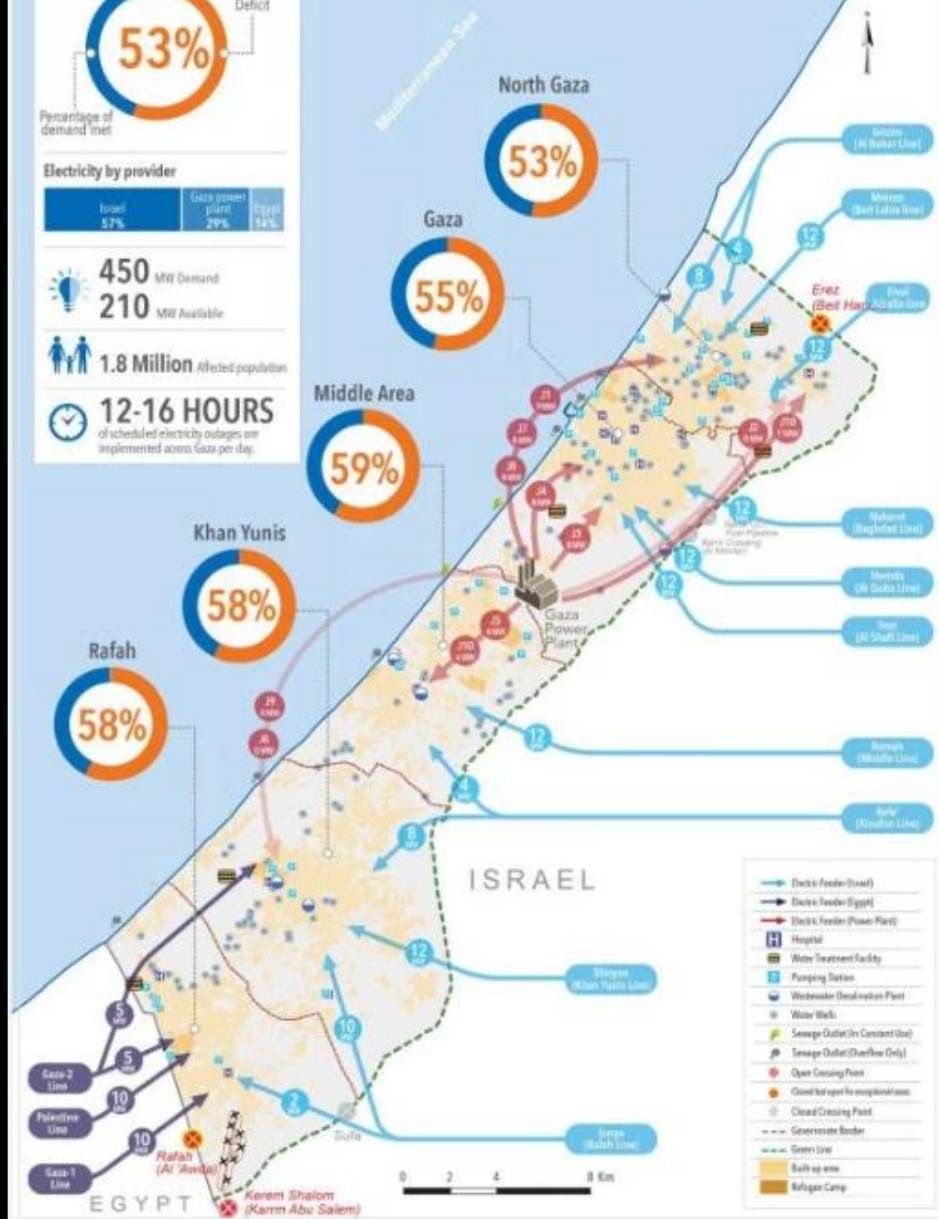

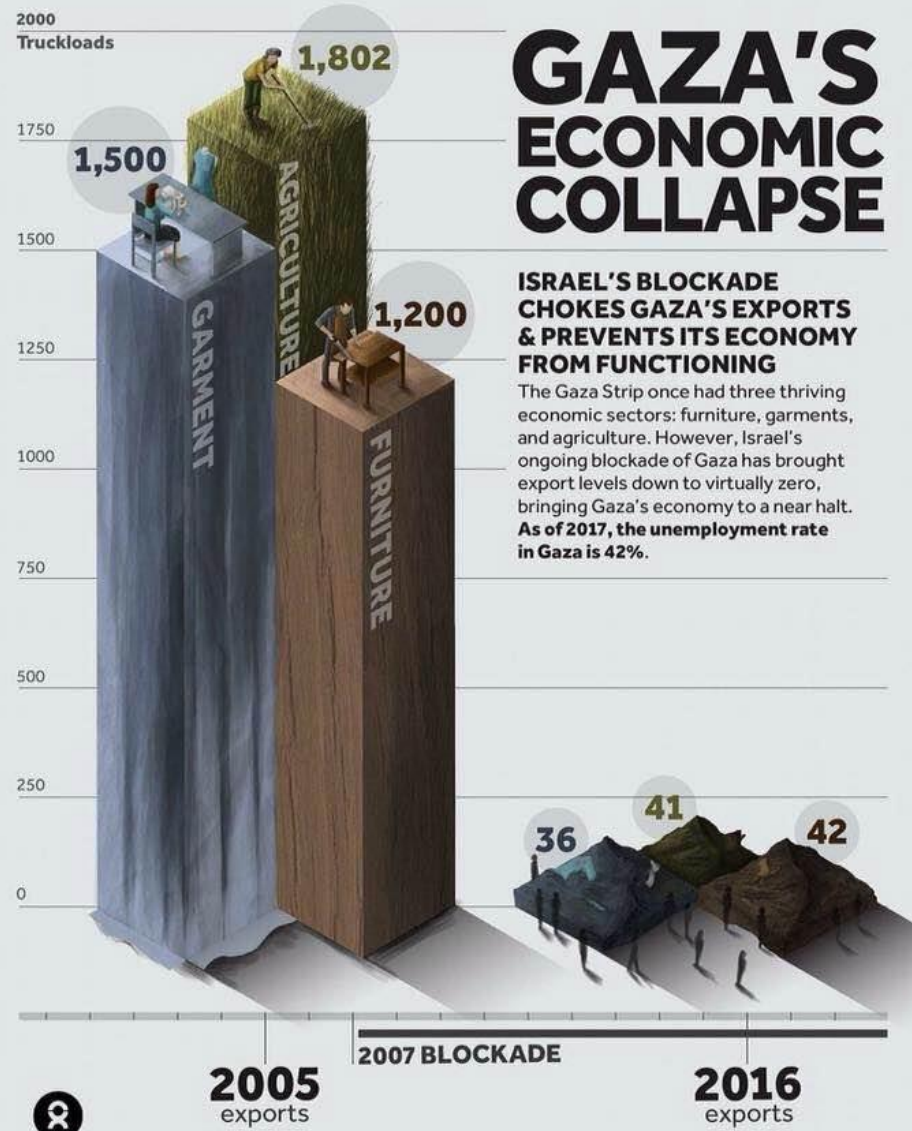

GAZA'S ECONOMIC COLLAPSE

ISRAEL'S BLOCKADE CHOKES GAZA'S EXPORTS & PREVENTS ITS ECONOMY FROM FUNCTIONING

The Gaza Strip once had three thriving economic sectors: furniture, garments, and agriculture. However, Israel's ongoing blockade of Gaza has brought export levels down to virtually zero, bringing Gaza's economy to a near halt. **As of 2017, the unemployment rate in Gaza is 42%.**

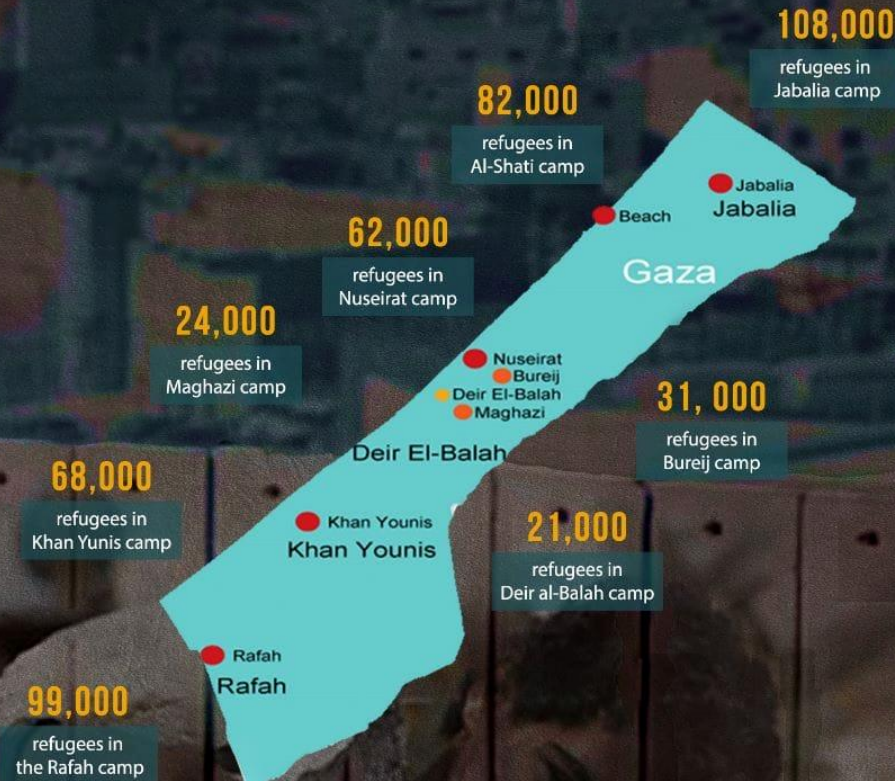

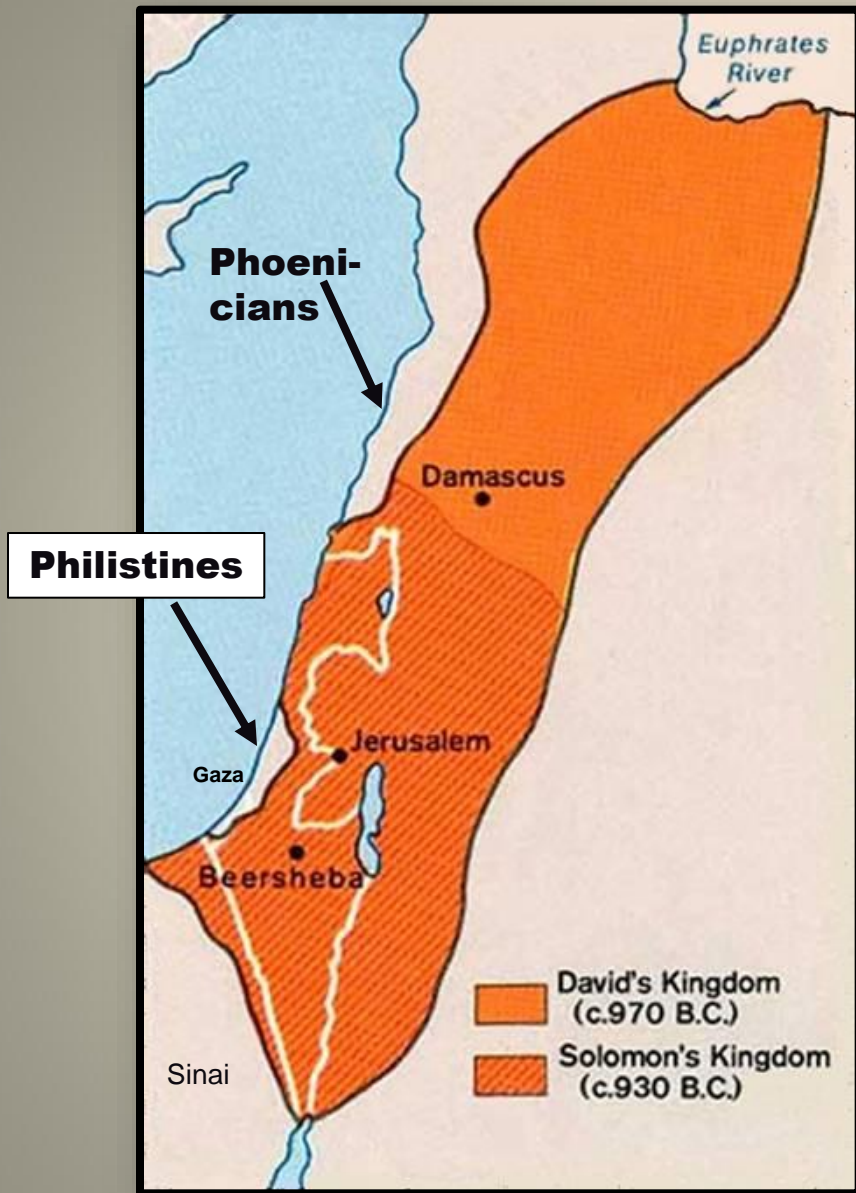

These peoples drive out or mingle with the pre-existing population:

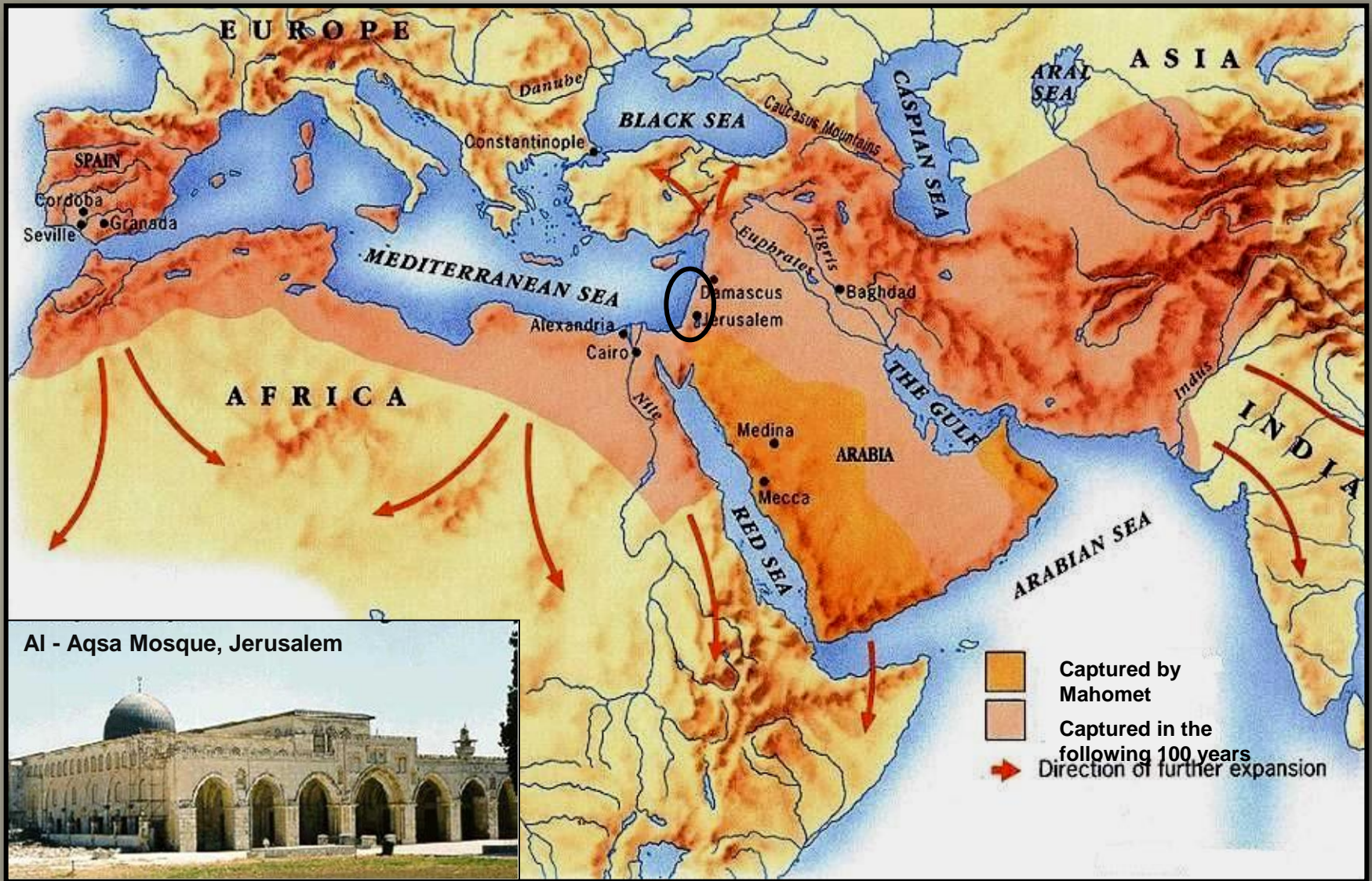
the **Canaanites**.

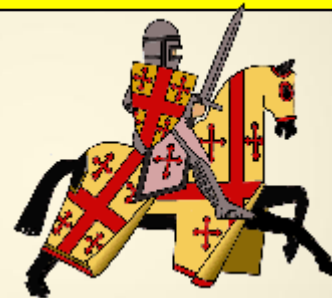

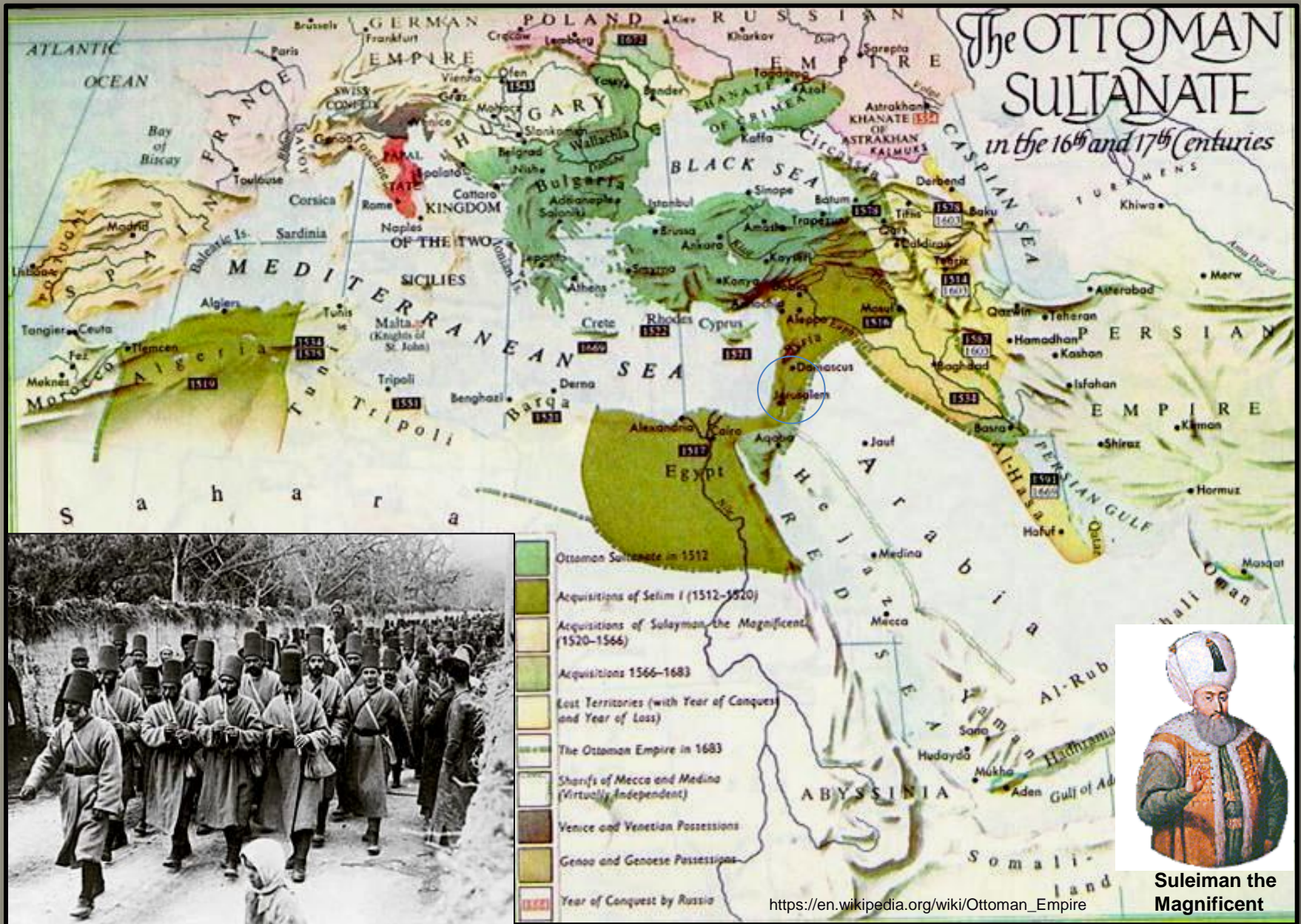

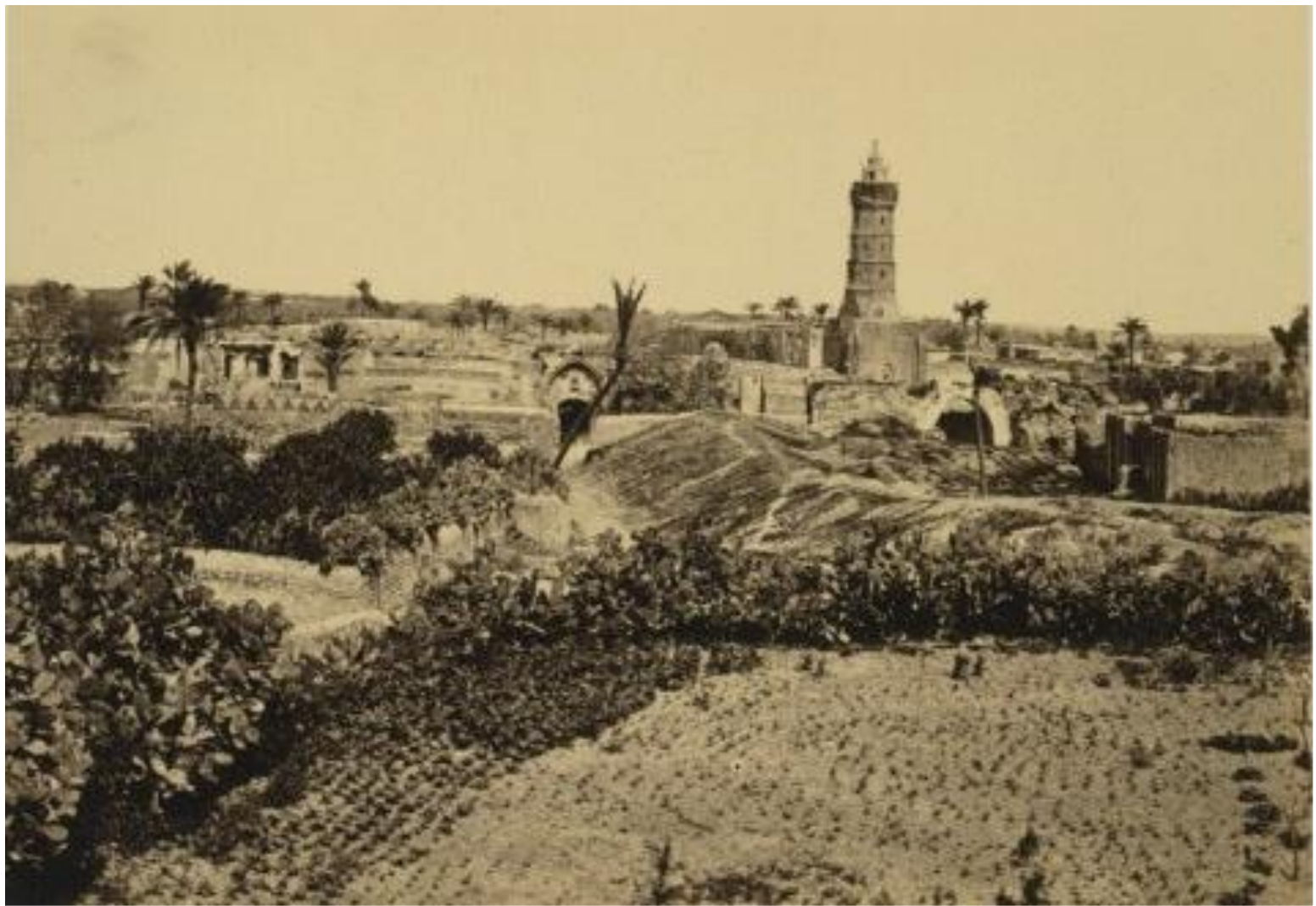

The Great Mosque in Gaza was last destroyed by the Israelis in 2023

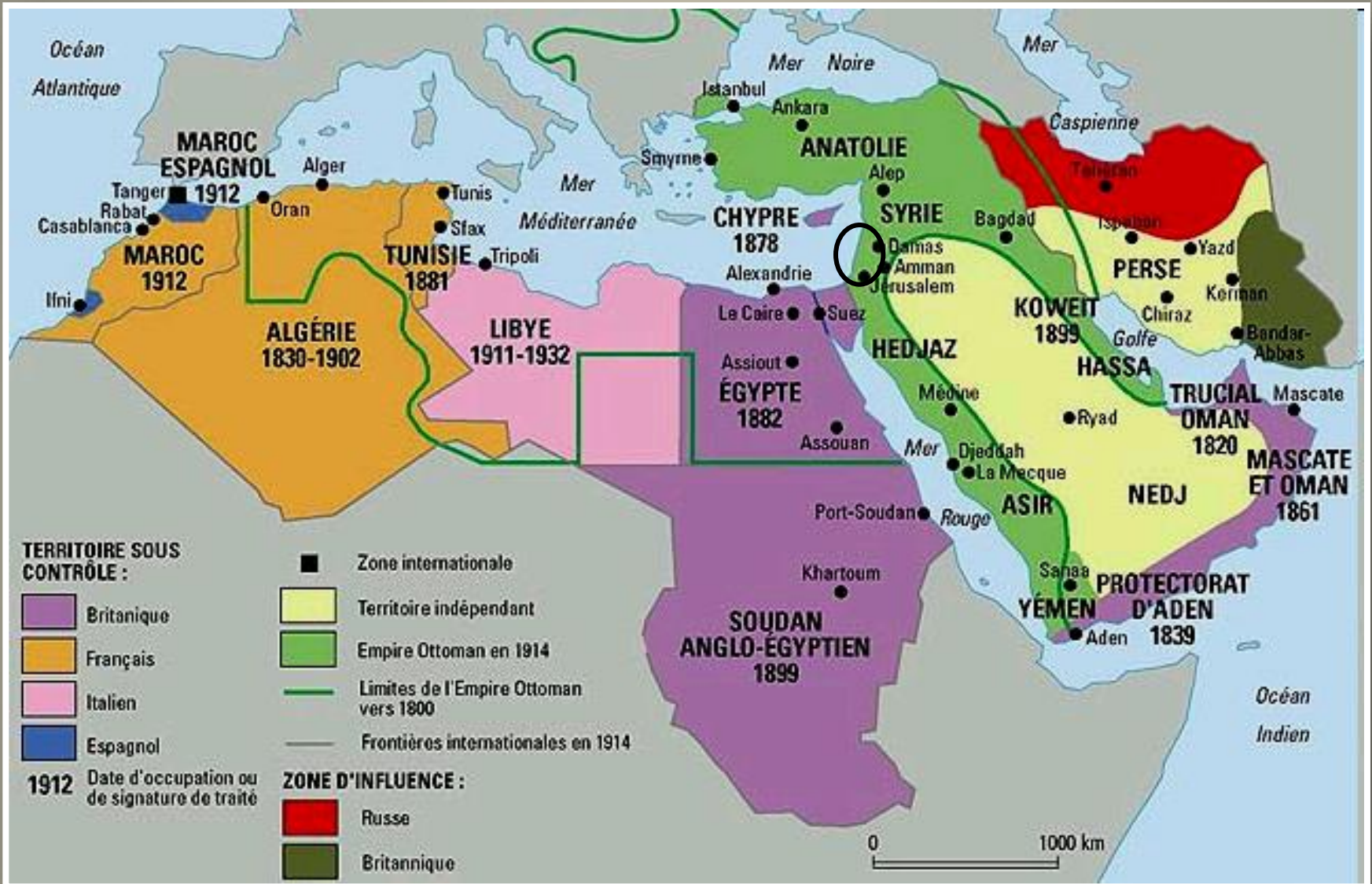


Located on Al-Wahda Street in downtown Gaza, this imposing stone building dates back to the Mamluk period (1300 - 1500). It is known as Qasr al-Basha because Napoleon spent a few nights here on his way through the town in 1799. This mosque, and many others, was destroyed in 2023 by the Israelis.

Gaza - The great Mosque

The great mosque of Gaza was built about 2000 years ago as a pagan temple. Around 400 it became a Christian church. In 637 it became a mosque and in 1100 again a Christian temple. In 1178 it became a mosque again. From 1228 to 1244 it was again transformed into a Christian church. The Mamluk period followed, during which the mosque was joined by a Christian church. In 1799 Napoleon passed through it and in 1994 Yasser Arafat declared it the first territory freed from the Israeli occupation.





In 1839 the Turkish Ottoman Empire starts the modernization of the country, including Palestine.

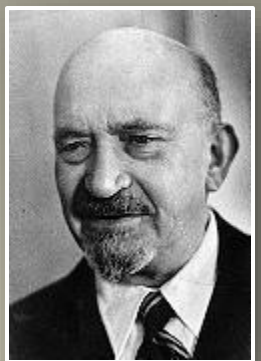

1897 - The beginning of Zionism

In Basel (Switzerland) the first Zionist congress presided over by Theodor Herzl proposes to establish in Palestine a State for the Jews. The options of Uganda and Argentina were rejected.

The purchase of land and the shipment of settlers to Palestine begins.

In order to raise the money, in 1901 the Jewish National Fund was founded.

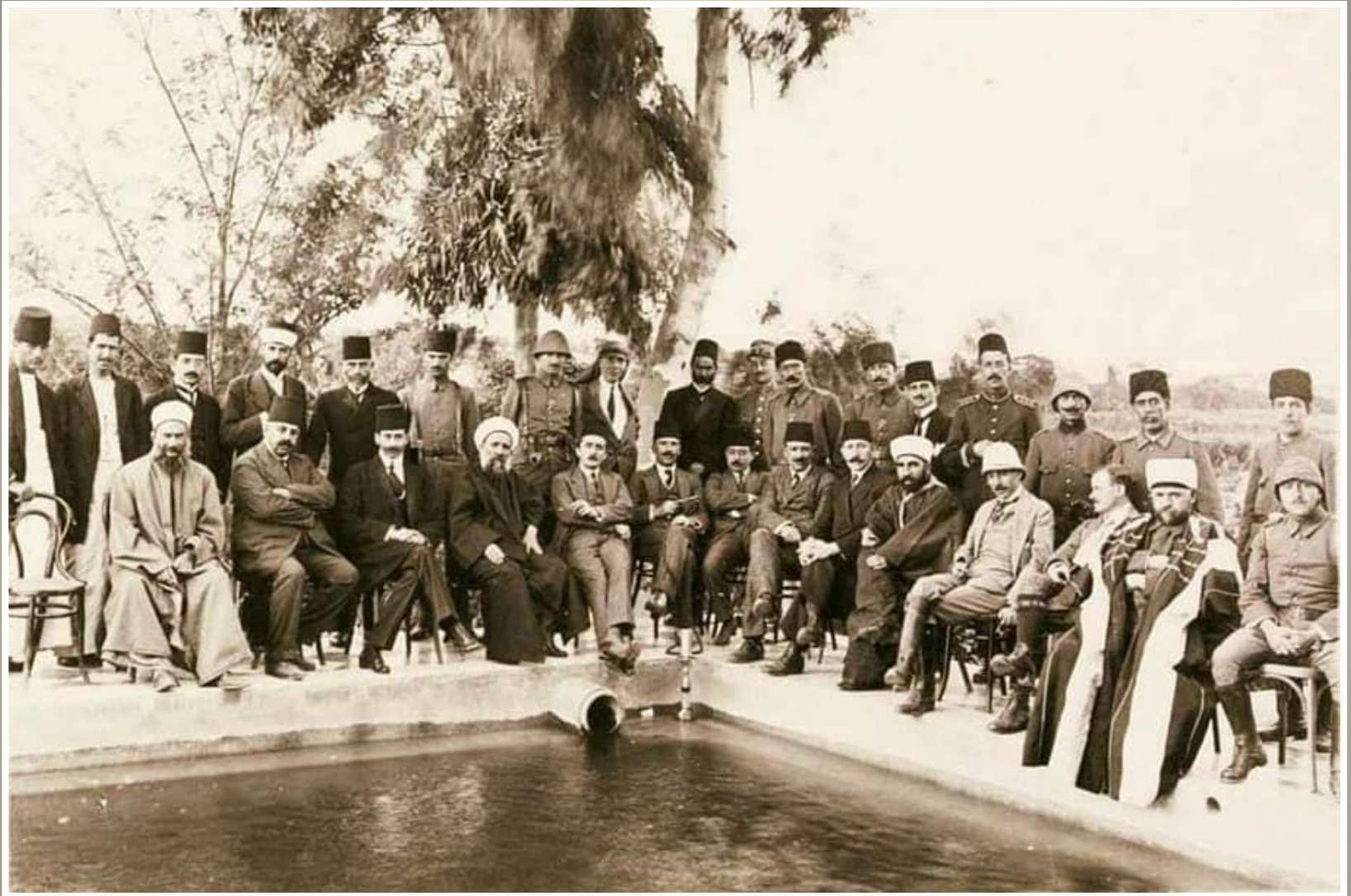

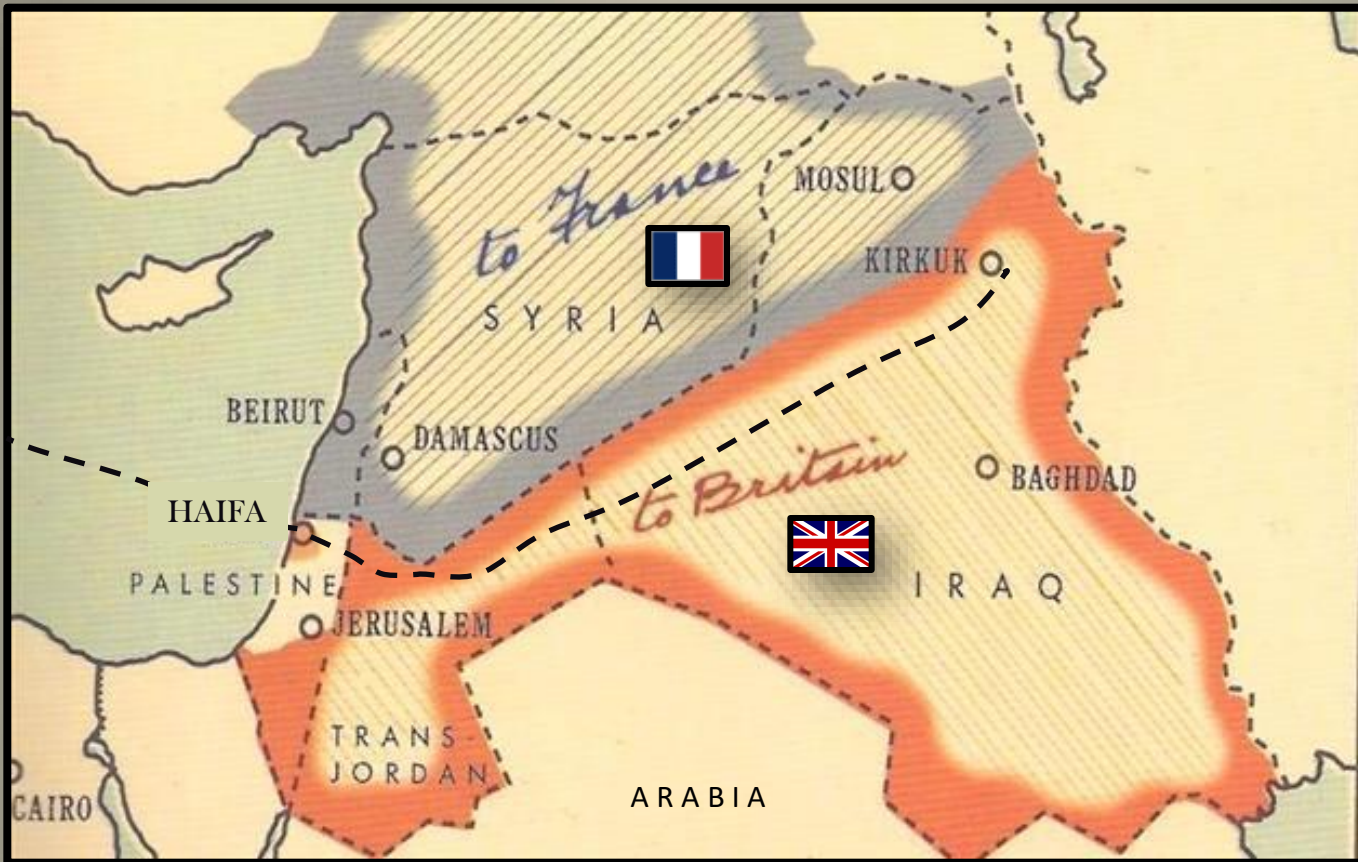

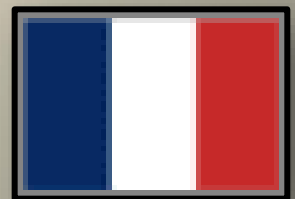

1916 - The (secret) Sykes-Picot agreement

With this secret agreement, England and France divide up the Middle East. This agreement must be considered in the context of the British colonial policy for the Middle East and the race for oil that became a strategic asset following World War I.

In 1934 the Kirkuk - Haifa oil pipeline was built, through Transjordan and Palestine to Haifa where refining and embarkation for England took place.

Dear Lord Rothschild,

I have much pleasure in conveying to you, on behalf of His Majesty's Government, the following declaration of sympathy with Jewish Zionist aspirations which has been submitted to, and approved by, the Cabinet

"His Majesty's Government view with favour the establishment in Palestine of a national home for the Jewish people, and will use their best endeavours to facilitate the achievement of this object, it being clearly understood that nothing shall be done which may prejudice the civil and religious rights of existing non-Jewish communities in Palestine, or the rights and political status enjoyed by Jews in any other country"

I should be grateful if you would bring this declaration to the knowledge of the Zionist Federation.

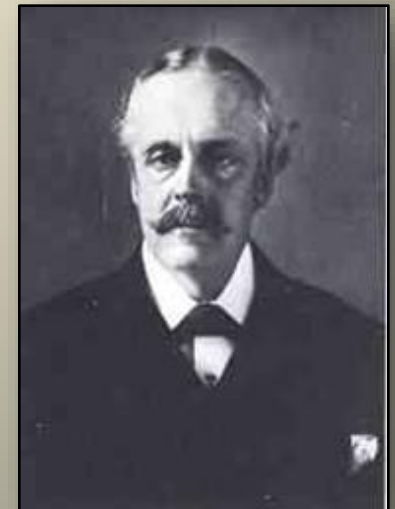


The Balfour Declaration

The British government declares itself favourable to the establishment in Palestine of a « national home » for the Jews. Condition: nothing shall be done which may prejudice the civil and religious rights of the non-Jewish communities in Palestine.

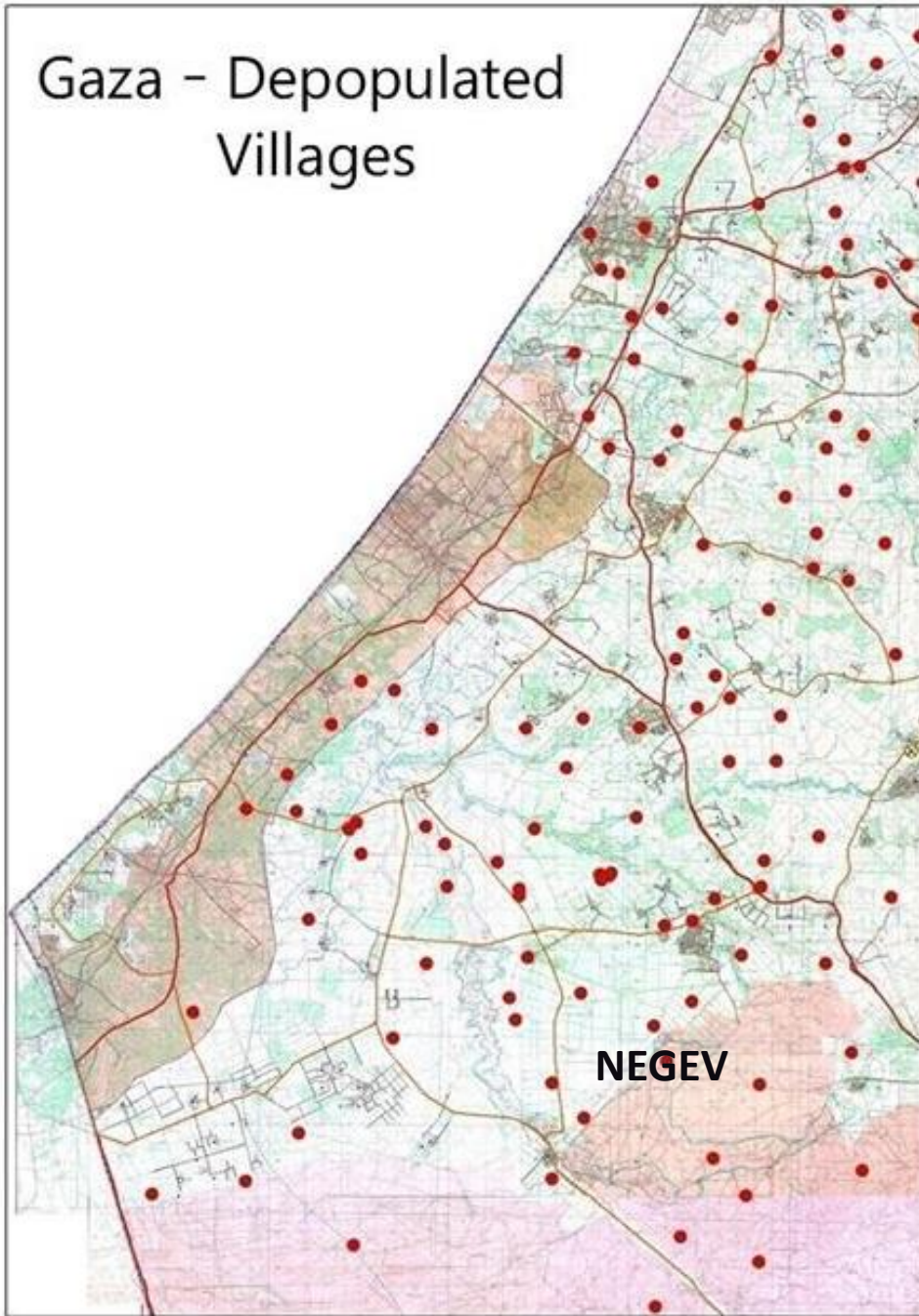
“On **March 10, 1948**, eleven men held a meeting in the Red House, headed by Ben Gurion. The eleven decided to expel one million Palestinians from historical Palestine.” (Ilan Pappé)

The Zionists started planning the ethnic cleansing of Palestine in 1940. Plan D (Dalet) entered the implementation phase in March **1948**.



A detachment of Israeli soldiers with motorized support during an attack on a small village in the Negev area of Palestine on Jan. 6, 1949. Subsequently the survived Palestinians will be killed or driven out (most will take refuge in Gaza) and the village will be destroyed. After a few years the area will be occupied and inhabited by the Zionist settlers.

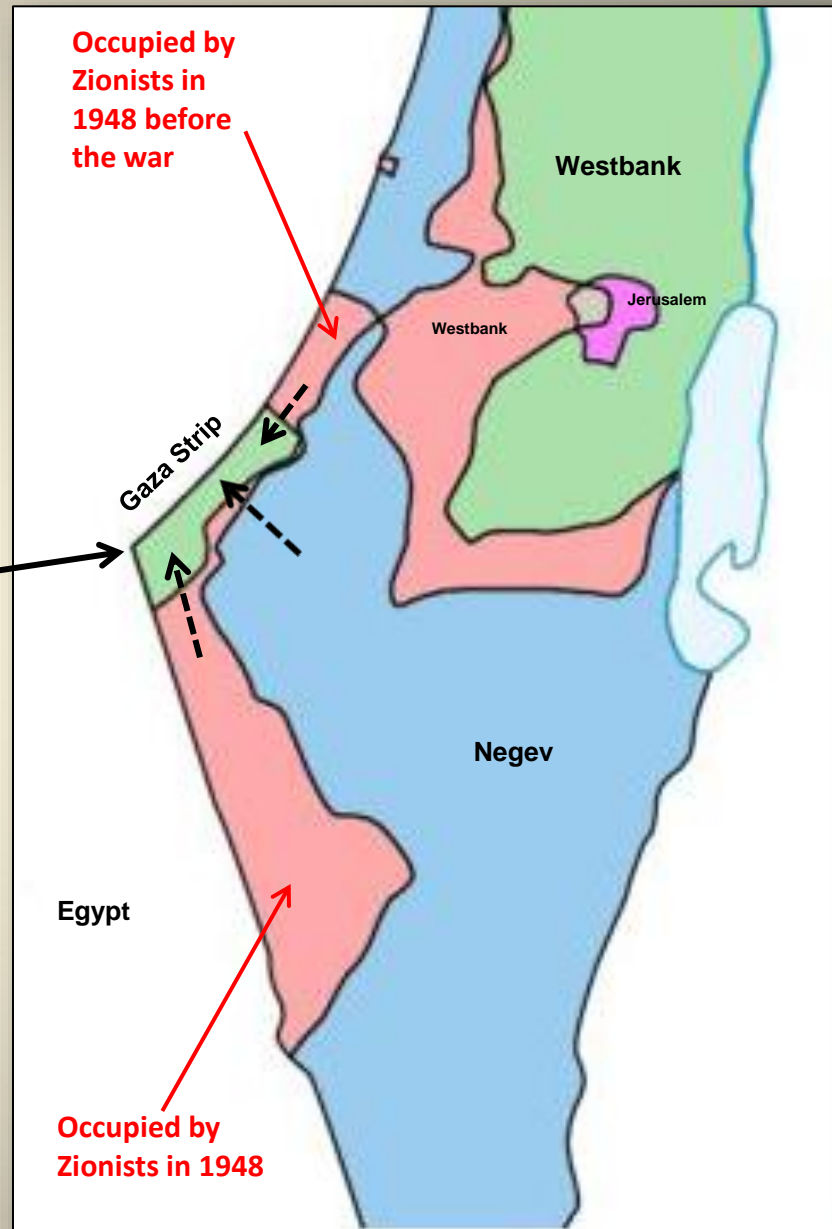


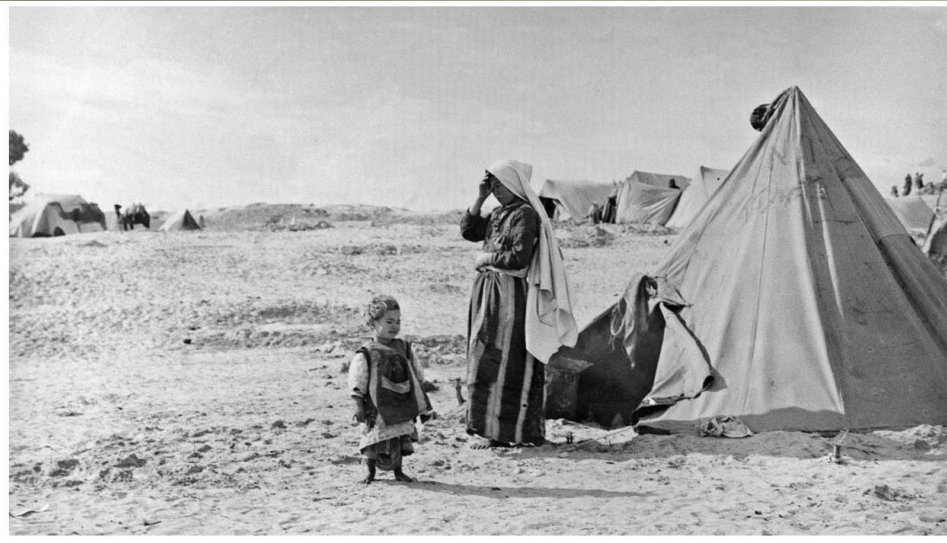

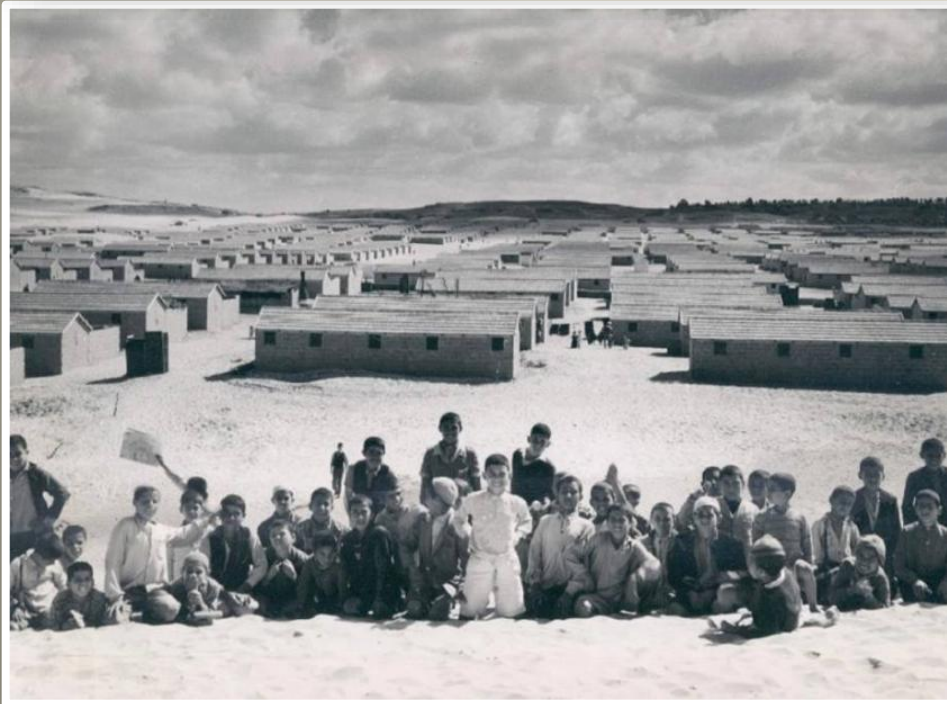

The property robbing

The Havat Shikmim farm of Sharon family near Sderot covers 4 km² and is specialized in the breeding of sheep.

The farm belonged to the Palestinian family Abuelaish who in May 1948 had to take refuge in the Gaza Strip. In 1972 the Israeli Land Administration assigned / leased the farm to Ariel Sharon. The current head of the family and its rightful owner, the Palestinian Izzeldin Abuelaish, is a doctor and is forced to live as refugees in Gaza where he can see his land usurped by the Zionists. During an Israeli bombardment three daughters of Mr Abuelaish were killed.

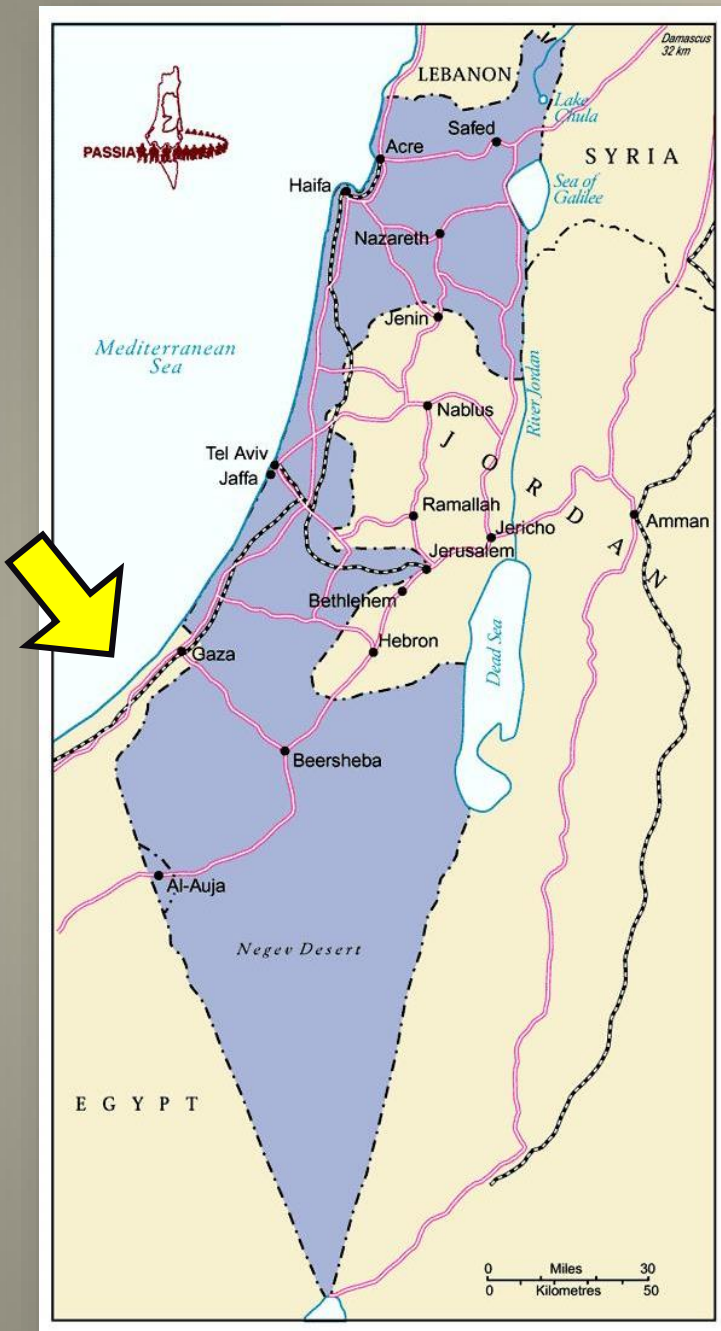

Gaza, 1950

Sponsored by Egypt, Palestinians declare the State of Palestine.

Only the Arab States, without Transjordan, recognized the Palestinian State.

In 1956 Israel invaded the Gaza Strip and the All Palestine Government had to take refuge in Egypt where it was dissolved a few years later.

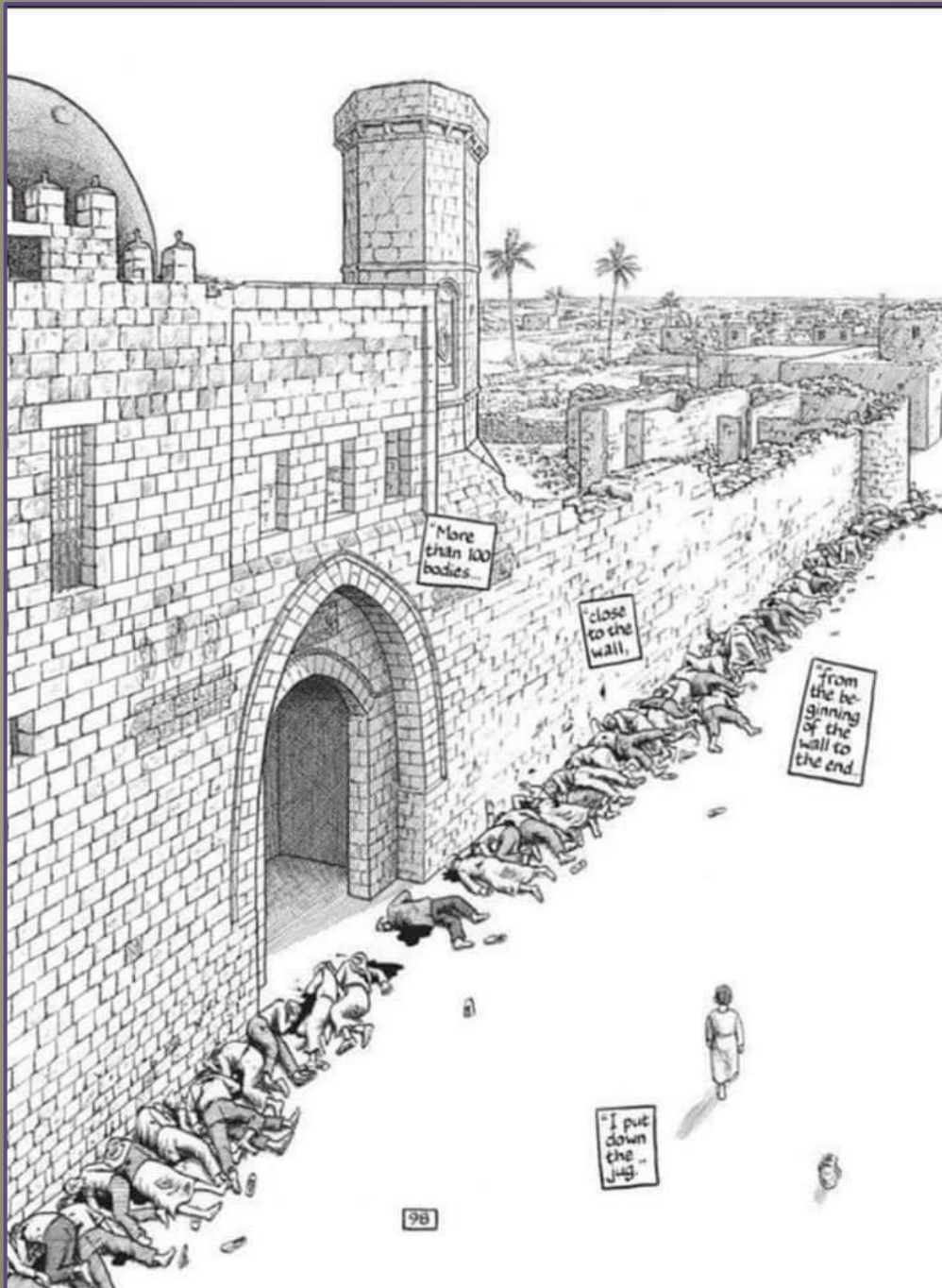

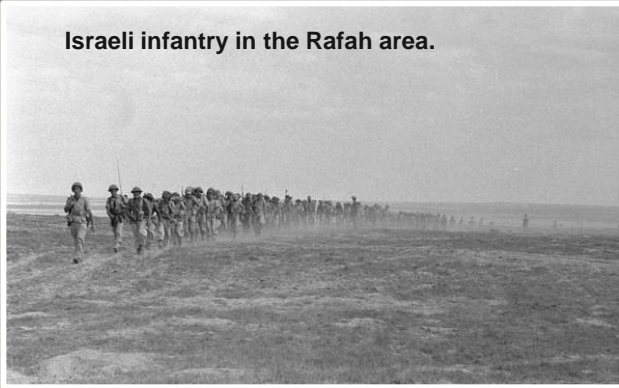

The Israelis occupy the Gaza Strip. In November 1956 they massacre more than 100 civilian and military prisoners in Rafah, 275 civilians in Khan Younis and 60 civilians in Gaza City. In 1957 was discovered a mass grave with 40 bodies. From 1948 to 1956, and from 1957 to 1967 the Gaza Strip was Egyptian territory.

2006 - The Hamas government

Hamas democratically won the elections in the occupied territories and formed the new Palestinian government including also some independent personalities. Israel and the USA called to boycott this Palestinian government considered “terrorist”. This boycott creates serious difficulties to all the Palestinian population. Some months later Israel puts 8 ministers and about 60 Palestinian MPs under arrest.

Israeli Occupation Forces (IOF) Escalate Attacks on Palestinian Civilians and Property in the Occupied Palestinian Territory (OPT) and Launch an Unprecedented Media Campaign in the Gaza Strip

- 41 Palestinians, 23 of whom were civilians, including 9 children, 3 women and two disabled persons, were killed by IOF in the Gaza Strip.

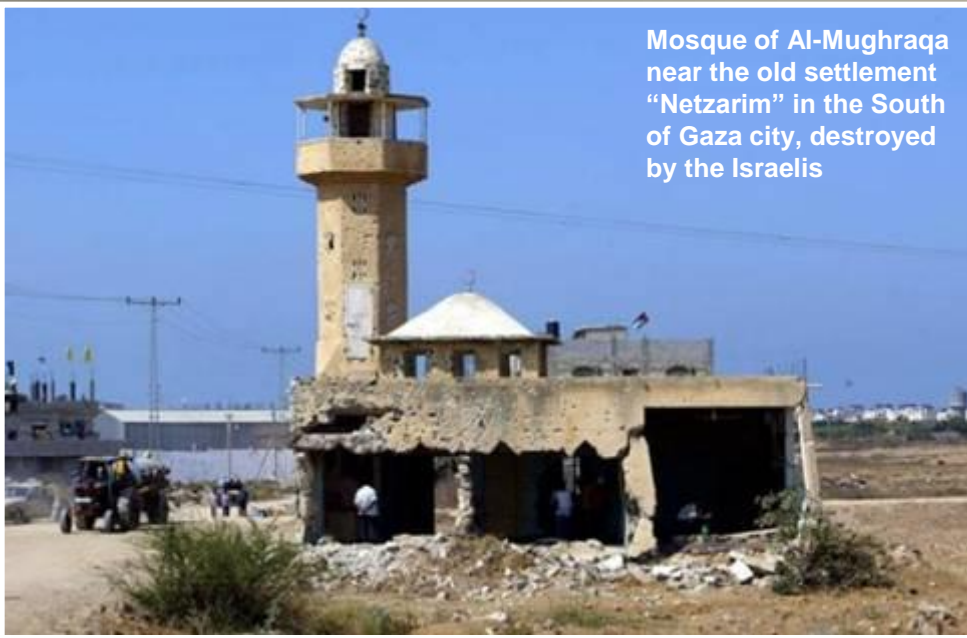

The border between the Gaza Strip and Egypt

To prevent transit between the Gaza Strip and Egypt the Israelis have built a 300 - 400 m wide security strip called the **Philadelphi Corridor**. There is only one crossing point near the city of Rafah.

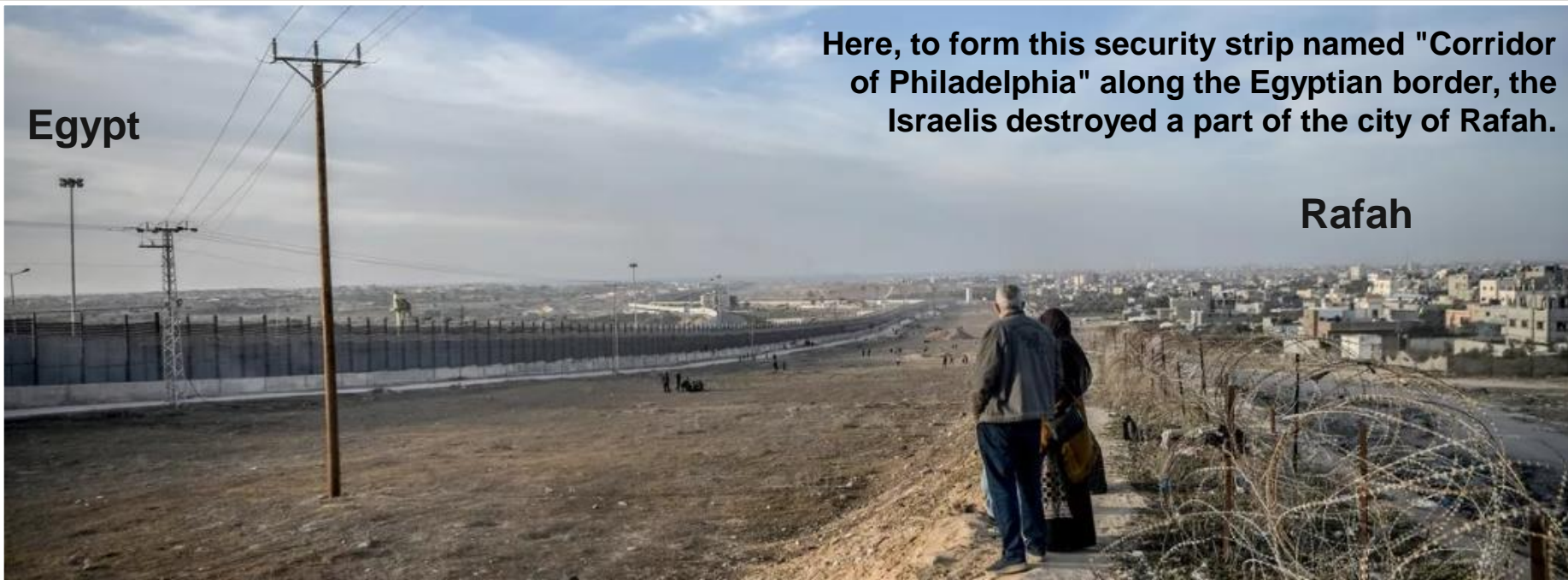


Following an agreement between Egypt and Israel since 2005 Egypt has assumed control of the Philadelphi Corridor but Israel has maintained supervision and since 2006 Israel has closed the only passage between the Strip and Egypt in Rafah which to date has only been reopened occasionally creating a great economic damage to the inhabitants of the Strip.

Here, to form this security strip named "Corridor of Philadelphia" along the Egyptian border, the Israelis destroyed a part of the city of Rafah.

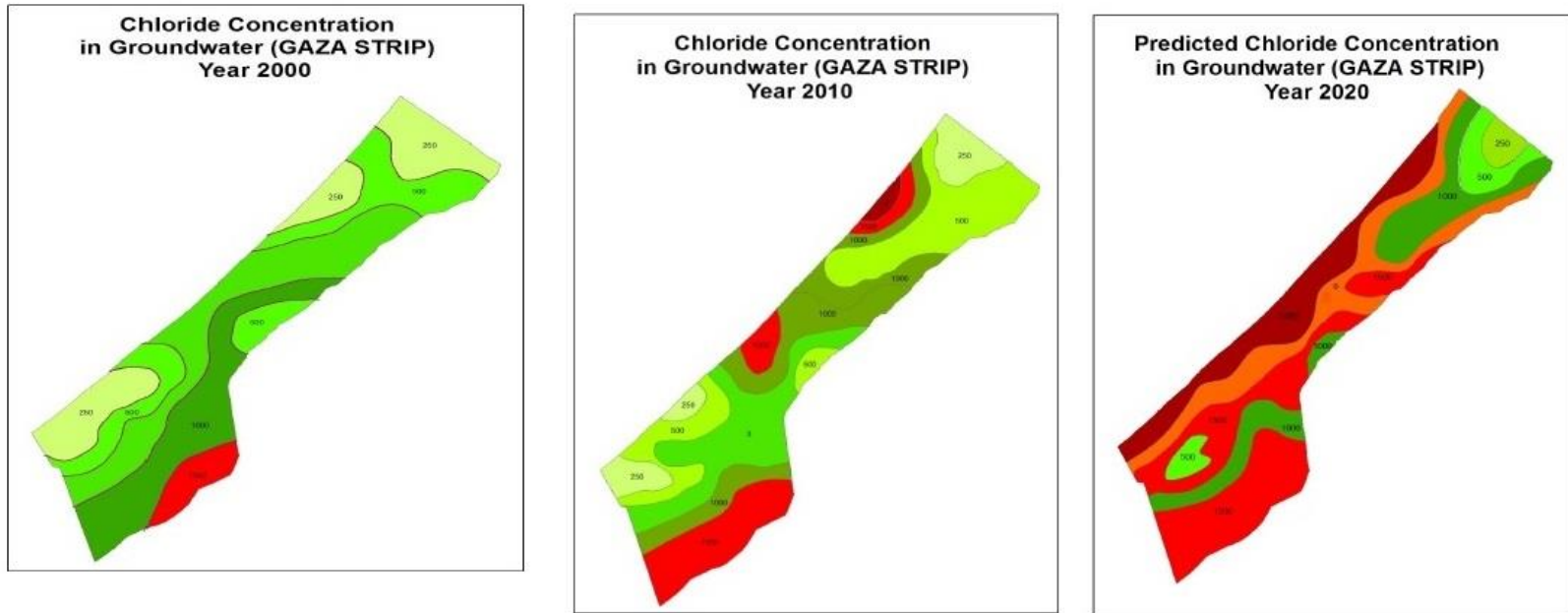
Due to the excessive exploitation of groundwater sea water enters the basement of the Gaza Strip.

The groundwater is heavily polluted also because sewage systems are damaged by Israeli bombing and electricity lack, neglect, and more. Until the last day of the colonies withdrawal in 2005, the Israelis buried in Gaza Strip a lot of toxic industrial waste. Now this waste contribute to the chemical water pollution.

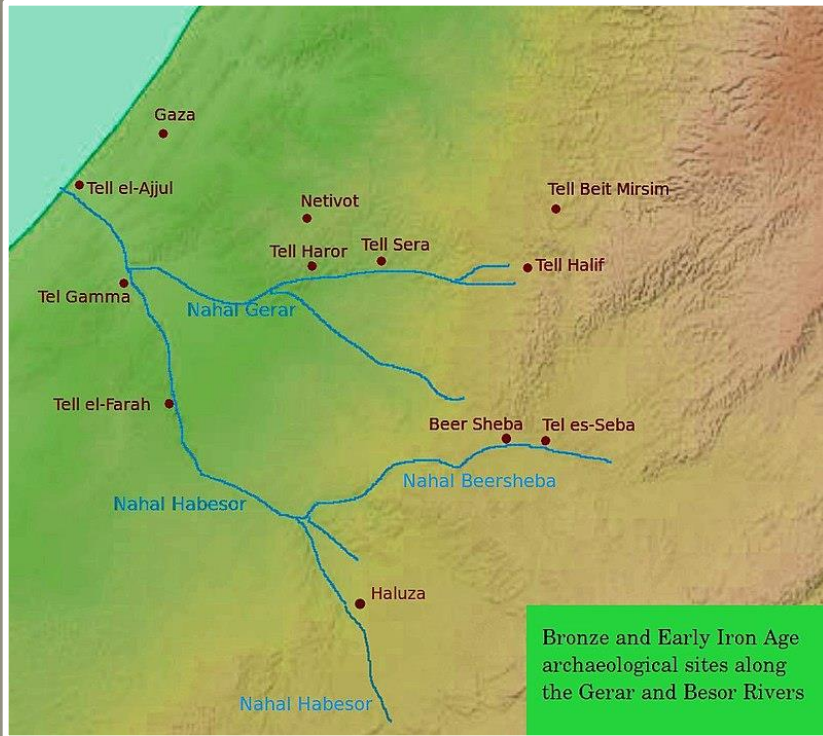

The Wadi Ghazzah River is the longest in Palestine. It starts from Hebron, collects water from the Negev and flows into the Mediterranean in the Gaza Strip. The Israelis take all the water from it and then pour into the river the wastewater that arrives in the Strip. Sometimes the Israelis open the dams creating large floods in the Strip, moreover the Israelis deny the existence of these dams.

The Israeli Dahiya doctrine

The Dahiya doctrine is a military strategy invented by the Israeli General Gadi Eizenkot, with whom during an asymmetrical conflict in an urban context the army deliberately hitting civilian infrastructure in order to create suffering to the civilian population with the intent to create deterrence.

The Dahiya doctrine (including the attacks in Gaza and all other measures against the Palestinians - military, legal, administrative, etc.) is the result of a growing of nationalism and radicalism in Israel. It follows that in Israel, as more you are strict with the Palestinians and more you are popular.

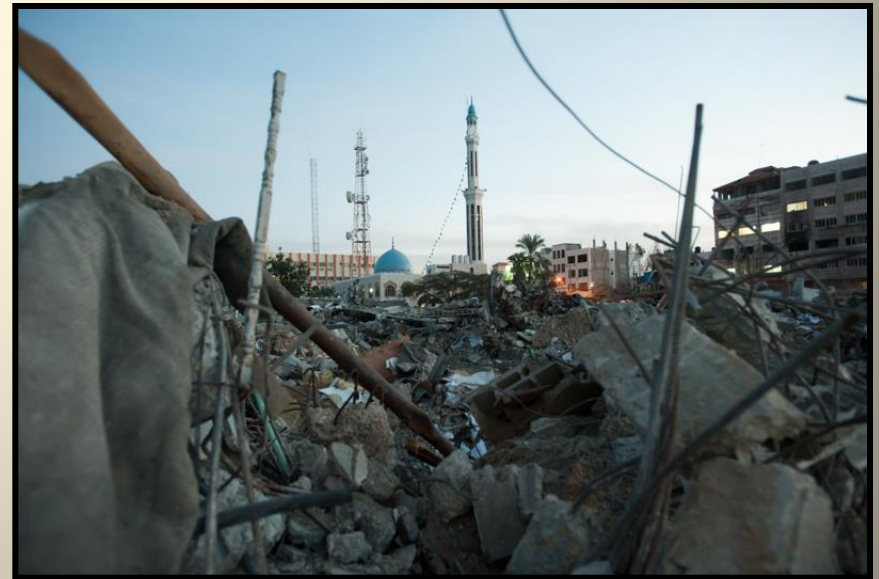

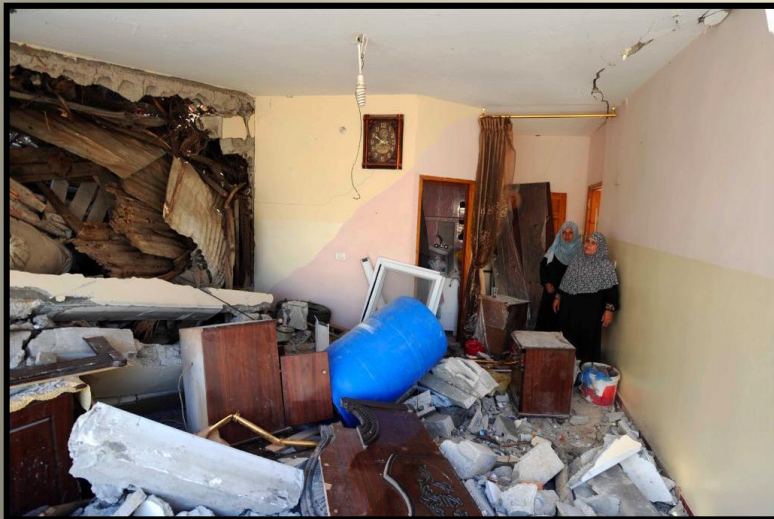

By bombing businesses in al-Rimal and elsewhere, Israel was inflicting damage on Gaza's economy that would be difficult to repair, the human rights group Al-Haq has suggested. Al-Haq noted that Gaza's economy was already on the brink of collapse before the May 2021 offensive began. Israel destroyed or damaged an estimated 525 businesses in Gaza last month. "The greatest destruction was to shops," said Ali al-Hayek from the Federation of Palestinian Industries. "The losses to goods prepared for Eid al-Fitr were very heavy, especially in the al-Rimal neighborhood. This beautiful commercial neighborhood was turned into a pile of rubble." The official unemployment rate in Gaza stood at 48 percent ahead of last month's attack. According to al-Hayek, it would not be surprising if the actual unemployment rate climbs to 70 percent because of the damage caused by Israel in May 2021.

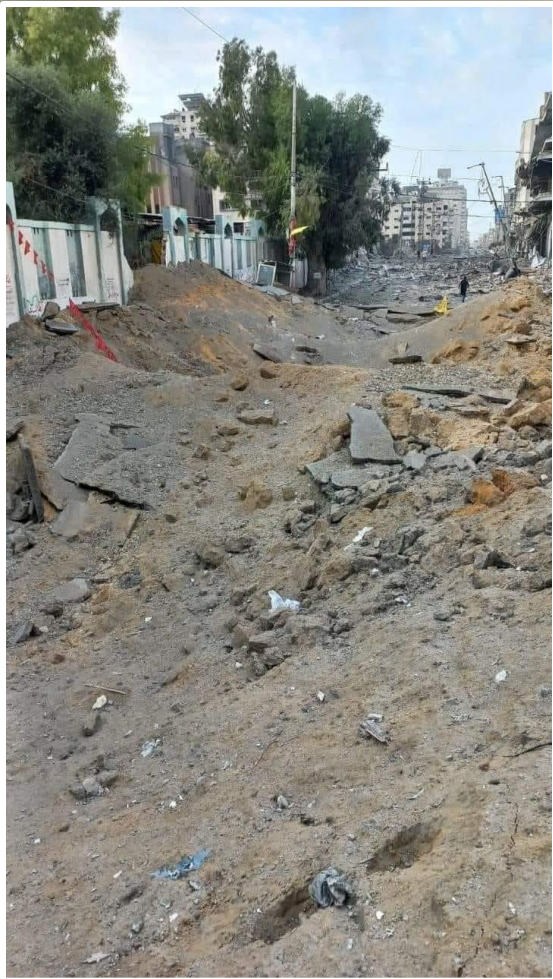

However, as the 2008-2009 conflict was assessed with lower resolution (2m) imagery, only the more severe damage was visible, and thus the comparison of the two resulting datasets utilized only the severely damaged and destroyed classes from 2009 and 2014.

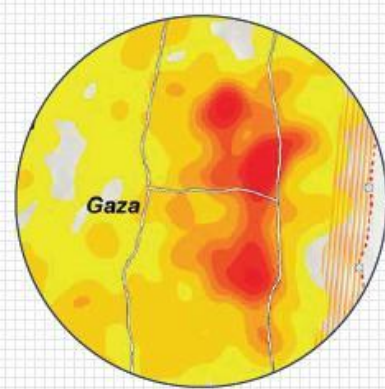
Comparison of the two time periods indicates that the 2014 conflict was much more destructive in terms of damage to buildings than the 2008-2009 conflict. The 2008-2009 conflict resulted in a total of 2,852 destroyed or severely damaged buildings detected by UNOSAT, while for 2014 the figure is 10,326. Even accounting for the possible error introduced by the reduced resolution imagery used to analyse the 2008-2009 conflict, this represents a relatively large increase in detected damage. Spatial distribution of the damage is also much more widespread from the 2014 conflict when compared to the 2008-2009 conflict. In 2014, damage occurs in almost every portion of the Gaza Strip.

Epiconers of damage do appear to differ significantly from 2008-2009 compared to 2014. For example in 2008-2009 the Rafah border area adjoining Egypt was a prime focus of military activity and thus saw a large amount of destruction. While this area also saw destruction in 2014 it is markedly less intense than 2008-2009. In addition, while Beit Hanoun, Shejaiya, and other areas were heavily targeted in 2014 these same areas were relatively lightly damaged in 2008-2009.

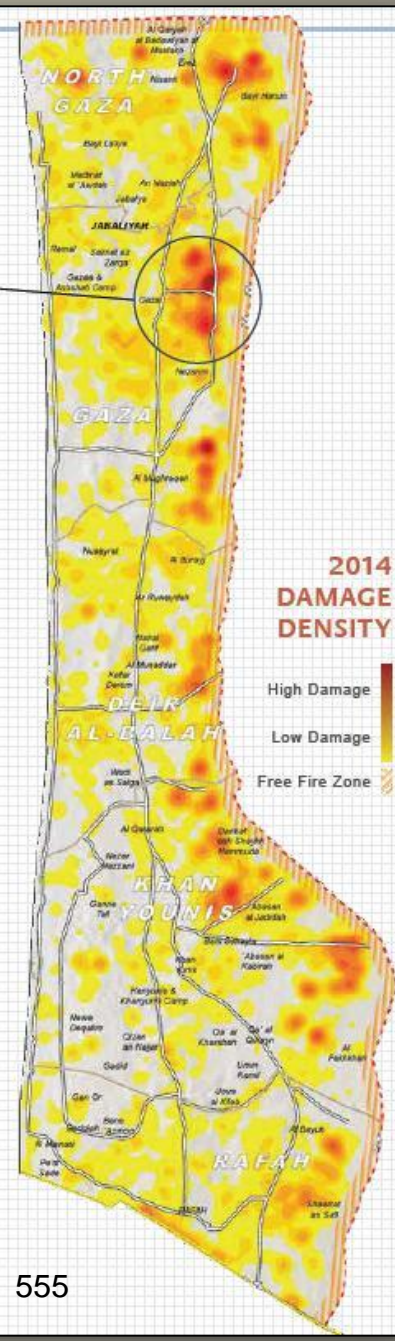
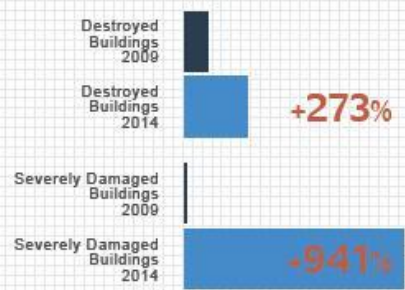

Of the total 10,326 buildings found with visible damage on imagery in Gaza, 30 percent (or 3,090 damaged buildings in total) were found inside the Gaza Governorate alone with 1,963 destroyed buildings and an additional 1,127 severely damaged buildings.

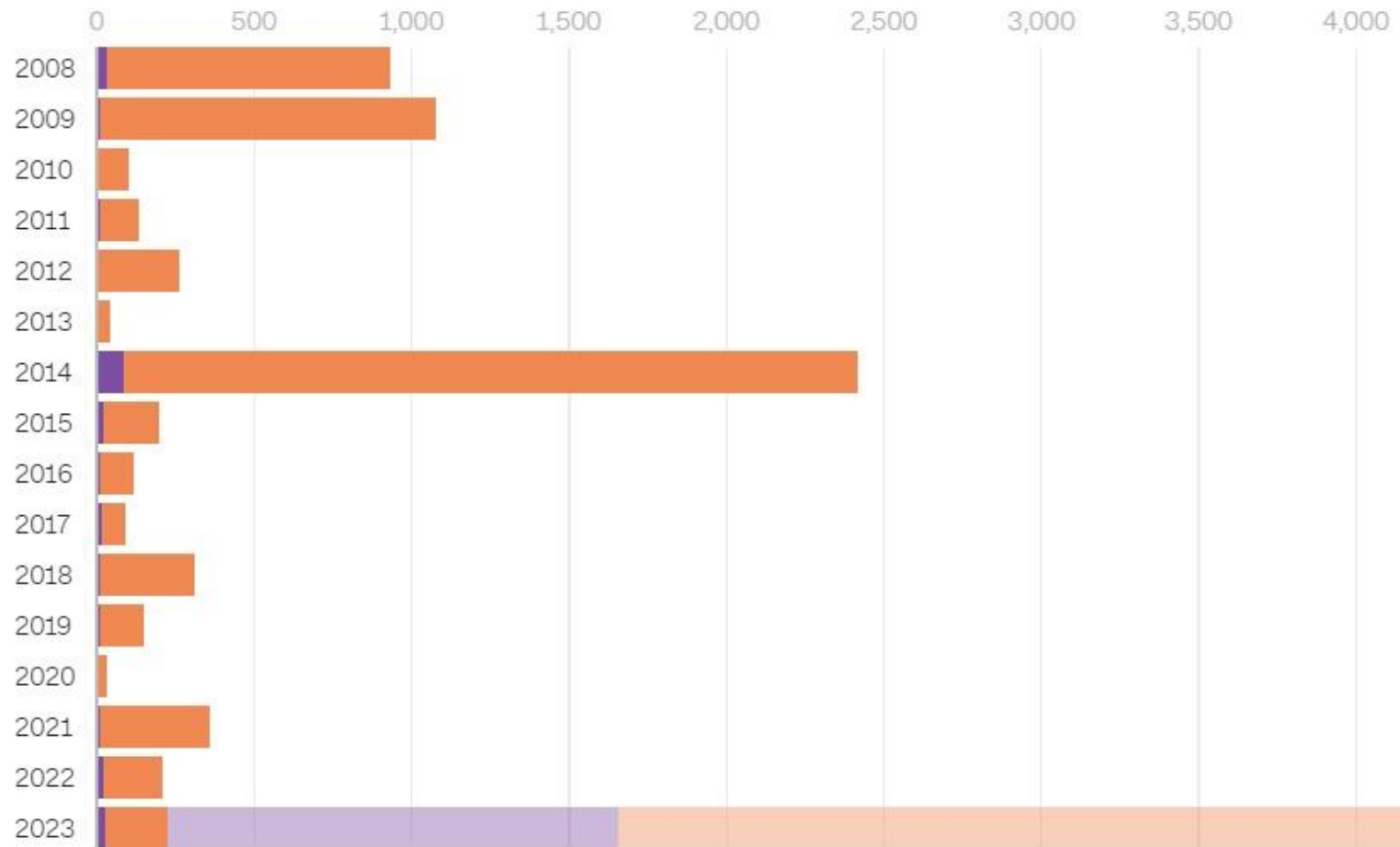

The mental health of Gaza's children

A study by Save the Children consulted **488 children and 160 parents and caregivers** in Gaza to measure **the impact 15 years of blockade** has had on children's mental health.

Children **reported feeling:**

84% Fearful **80%** Nervous **78%** Grief **77%** Sad

Children **exhibited these behaviours:**

79% Bedwetting **59%** Refusing to speak **48%** Difficulty concentrating

Many shared **vivid memories of the bombings they had experienced**, recalling how their homes and schools were destroyed, and their loved ones killed.

Requires urgent medical treatment outside Gaza but is unable to get a travel permit for her parents



Bassem* (8)

Was injured by an unexploded ordnance that damaged his eyes and hands



Momen* (10)

Suffers from nightmares after witnessing a man being ripped apart by Israeli shelling



May* (12)

Suffers from anxiety and nightmares after she was injured by an Israeli air raid that destroyed her house

The “Guevara” of Gaza

Mohammed Mahmoud Musleh Al-Aswad
6 January, 1946 Haifa - 9 March, 1973 Gaza



Released from Israeli prison in July 1970 after 2 and 1/2 Years jail, he was kept busy preparing, training and educating military groups. He became the commander of the PFLP military action in the Gaza Strip until his death just over two years later. "Guevara" was martyred in Gaza on 9 March, 1973, following a confrontation with the Israeli army

Vittorio Arrigoni

Vik for his friends

Besana in Brianza, Italy, 4 February 1975 -
Gaza, 15 April 2011

Was an Italian activist, journalist and writer. Arrigoni worked with the pro-Palestinian International Solidarity Movement (ISM) in the Gaza Strip, from 2008 until his death. Arrigoni maintained a website, Guerrilla Radio, and published a book of his experiences in Gaza during the 2008–09 Gaza War between Hamas and Israel. He was subsequently killed by Palestinian Salafists. His murder was condemned by various Palestinian groups.
