Poreign Office, November 2nd, 1917

Dear Lord Rothschild.

I have much pleasure in conveying to you, on behalf of His Majesty's Government, the following declaration of sympathy with Jewish Zionist aspirations which has been submitted to, and approved by, the Cabinet.

"His Majesty's Government view with favour the establishment in Palestine of a national home for the Jewish people, and will use their best endeavours to facilitate the achievement of this object, it being clearly understood that nothing shall be done which may prejudice the civil and religious rights of existing non-jewish communities in Palestine, or the rights and political status enjoyed by Jews in any other country"



The British government declares itself favourable to the establishment in Palestine of a «national home» for the Jews.















Some Palestinian notes and coins from the British Mandate period

In Palestine, these means of payment were put out of circulation by the Zionists in 1948.














The Palestinians citrus groves




In Palestine, the Arabs developed citrus cultivation.






 Jaffa Road in Jerusalem. Its apartment houses were built by Arabs and usurped in 1948 by Jews.







The UN General Assembly adopts

Resolution 181 that provides for the partition of Palestine into two States:

A Jewish State and an Arab State

In reality, the Zionists only implemented the secret partition agreement of Palestine concluded between Golda Meir and Abdullah 1. King of Jordan on 17 November 1947, and implemented the Dalet ethnic cleansing plan in March 1948 by forcibly appropriating three quarters of Palestine.

On March 10, 1948, Ben Gurion orders the expulsion of 1 million Arabs








The ethnic cleansing of Palestine by the Zionists officially began in March 1948 and practically to this day (2024) has never stopped.






1948 - 1949 **The Zionists** destroy about 500 Palestinian villages and cities.








al-Tantura, about 1950 - the village is uninhabited. Today the village is a "kibbutz beach resort" called Nahsholim.






The al-Tantura massacre 22-23 May 1948







1948 - Nahr El-Bared, Lebanon, the first camp for Palestinian refugees










Camp in Syria, 1948
























OCCUPATION







A typical Israeli illegal outpost, created on Palestinian land near As-Sawahira-ash-Sharqiya, southeast of Jerusalem established in september 2019. In 2023 Israel currently has 261 Jewish-only settlements and 'outposts' built on confiscated Palestinian land.



The colonization of the occupied territories: Zionist outpost


Mitzpeh Kramim outpost near Ramallah. The supreme court confirmed that settlers can remain despite it being built on Palestinian land.




In contrast to international conventions, the Israelis colonized the militarily conquered Palestinian territories




40'000 settlers live in the Israeli settlement of Ariel


Wall construction


















The Gaza strip

Israel bombs the Gaza Strip dozens of times, causing thousands of casualties and enormous damage.




















Israeli and Palestinian children killed From September 2000 – 2023






The Palestinians must leave
